

Cervical Cancer Incidence, SC and DHEC Regions, all races, 2011-2015






Cervical Cancer Incidence Rates by DHEC Regions, All Races, 2011-2015






Cervical cancer 5-year incidence trends for DHEC regions








Cervical Cancer Mortality Rates by DHEC Regions, All Races, 2011-2015

PEE DEE Trend took an "up-turn" from 2014-2015

PEE DEE has experienced a large decline in death rates since 2004, still highest in state


NOTE: Early stage = localized disease. Late Stage = Regional and Distant Disease

In situ carcinoma of the cervix is not collected.




Cervical cancer incidence rates for DHEC regions by race, 2011-2015

PEE DEE has >2x higher death rates for Black Women than for Whites

Black women have higher rates of cervical cancer deaths in each DHEC Region

SUMMARY OF THE CANCER DATA FOR PEE DEE REGION

Cervical Cancer

- Cervical Cancer Incidence
 - Pee Dee Region ranks highest among the regions
 - County numbers too small to rank
- Cervical Cancer Mortality
 - Pee Dee has highest rates among Regions, higher than state
 - County numbers too small to rank

Early-to-Late Stage Comparisons

Cervical cancer:

Pee Dee has <u>highest</u> proportion of late stage (~60%) among the Regions

Pee Dee had <u>Higher</u> than the state (55%), and the U.S. (~51%) late stage proportions



Racial Disparities – Black-to-White Comparison for Incidence

Cervical Cancer:

For SC – Black incidence is 22% higher than that of Whites

For Pee Dee – Black incidence is 29% higher than that of Whites



Racial Disparities – Black-to-White Comparison for Mortality

Cervical Cancer

For SC - Black death rate nearly double that of Whites

For Pee Dee - Black death rate **170% higher** than for Whites
