

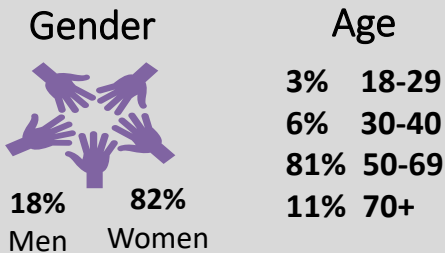


Colon Health Program Evaluation Outcomes

Summary

The Colorectal Cancer event, held in August, was attended by approximately 44 men and women. Dr. Gerald Wilson, retired surgeon from Columbia, SC, was the keynote speaker. Quality of the Program

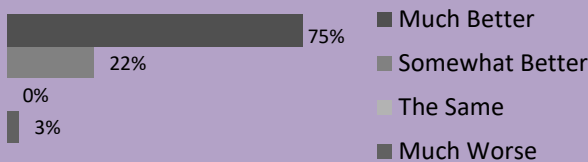
92 percent of participants strongly agreed or agreed the presentation was **well organized**.

97 percent of participants strongly agreed or agreed the format of the presentation was **appropriate**.

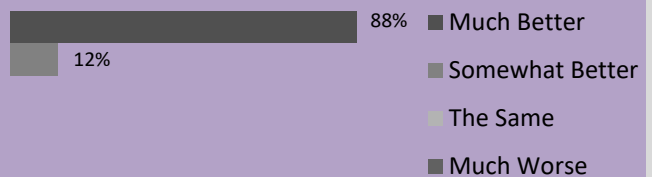
82 percent of participants strongly agreed or agreed the information they received during the presentation was **helpful**.
