DID YOU KNOW...

African American men are disproportionately impacted by cancer in South Carolina. **Talk to your doctor about your family history, risk factors and the tests that are right for you.**



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DID YOU KNOW...

The lifetime risk for developing cancer is 1 in 3.
The most commonly diagnosed cancers in men are prostate, lung, colon, bladder, and melanoma. **Talk to your doctor about the tests that are right for you.**



DID YOU KNOW...

Many cancers are preventable, but some individuals are at a greater risk than others. **Talk to your doctor about what you can do to reduce your risk.** Between 40 and 80% of cancers are thought to be preventable by living healthier lives.



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DID YOU KNOW...
