



2022 ALLIANCE SURVEY RESULTS

This survey aims to assess the composition of the Alliance's constituents and gather feedback to improve our programs and services. This survey was reviewed by 227 constituents and completed by 64.


The following chart indicates how familiar the survey respondents are with the mission of the South Carolina Cancer Alliance and the purpose of the State Cancer Plan.




The percentage of respondents representing or working with a minority group or underserved population.




The ethnicity of the survey respondents.




The gender selected by the survey respondents.




The area code where the survey respondents reside.




The type of organization the survey respondents work for.

How the survey respondents receive information and updates about the South Carolina Cancer Alliance.




The percentage of survey resondents that agree with the following statement The Alliance helps advance and promote health equity in South Carolina




The percentage of survey respondents that agree with the following statement - The Alliance builds partnerships with key stakeholders to guide cancer prevention and control efforts throughout the state
